# Summer Sonic Parent Guide

## How Sonic Works

- Sonic is open from 7:00am – 5:00pm. A light Breakfast is available from 7:00am – 9:00am daily.
- **We will go on field trips everyday this summer. Everyone will be out of the building from 10:00am – 3:00pm, unless otherwise noted. There is not a stay-back option.**
- Each week you will be e-mailed the newsletter for the upcoming week for all registered weeks. This newsletter provides the details & times for the next week's fieldtrips. Please make sure the main office has your correct e-mail address on file.
- Youth are required to sign-in everyday when they arrive. Sign-out is required by an adult unless parents have given staff specific instructions that youth can sign themselves out.
- Attendance and the morning meeting begin around 9:30am; please ensure that you arrive by this time each day.

## Summer begins June 10<sup>th</sup>!

Summer Sonic begins on Monday, June 10<sup>th</sup> and runs through Friday, August 9<sup>th</sup>.

Please note: Sonic will be closed July 4th & 5th

### What to Bring Everyday

At Summer Sonic we require that youth bring the following items with them each day:

- Bag Lunch
- Sunscreen
- Water bottle
- Field-trip appropriate foot wear

We recommend that Sonic youth also bring the following:

- Swimsuit
- Towel
- Socks
- Optional spending money

### We have a set of expectations regarding the use of cell phones & other electronic devices while at Sonic:

- Youth may bring them and use them while at Sonic and on field trips but do so entirely **at their own risk**- staff will not be responsible for watching youth's phones/chrome books/etc.
- If youth use electronics while at Sonic they must do so appropriately- failure to do so will result in them being taken away by the staff and returned to the youth's parent at the end of the day.



### The Edina Pool Option

The Sonic youth will have many options to choose from each week. In general, the Edina Pool is offered as an option, two or more days a week.

We strongly recommend purchasing a pool pass from the city of Edina if your youth will be choosing to go to the pool often.

For those without a pool pass, there is an additional cost of \$11.50 for each trip to the pool, which must be in cash and paid at the pool on that day.

Sonic youth will be responsible for either paying at the gate or showing their pass to get into the pool.

Sonic will not pay for Edina pool admissions, as this is only an option and not a mandatory event.

Edina Pool passes are available for purchase through the City of Edina's web site.

## In Case of Rain

Occasionally during the summer, we experience rain and other inclement weather, as many of our field trips are outdoors and planned well in advance, we do our best to follow the events on our calendar.
