

Attendance Protocol Updates 2017-2018

Students who incur 2 unexcused absences in any academic offering (advisory, flexblock, course offering, or student prep) will be temporarily ineligible from the following student opportunities:

In order to be eligible to participate in lost student opportunities, students must recover time lost during teacher office hours or detention (learning academic/social plan). Absences that are recovered will be updated in Infinite Campus to reflect an unexcused absence (AUNK). Examples of unexcused absences include, but are not limited to, transportation miscue, oversleeping, skipping, etc.

Students who have **three (3) unexcused absences** during one semester will be placed on an attendance contract.

Students who have **four (4) unexcused absences** during one semester who have been placed on an attendance contract may receive no credit for the course and be placed in a classroom-based student prep.

Attendance Appeals Process

After 4 unexcused absences, a meeting will be set up with the student, parent, counselor and administrator to review the issues concerning the student's attendance. The student can make an appeal to remain in the course. If a valid reason for absence exists, an intervention plan will be developed for the student to remain in the course.
