## CURRICULUM

A comprehensive curriculum of 140+ courses emphasizes preparation for college. Besides extensive offerings in English, mathematics, social studies and sciences, study in seven languages is offered: six years of French and Spanish, five in German and Latin, four in Japanese and three years in Chinese and American Sign Language (ASL). Please note: We do not offer first and second year classes in French. Sophomores in our 9-12 high school will typically take the third year of this language. One notable exception: approximately 40 French students in tenth grade have been part of our Immersion program since kindergarten; as sophomores, they will take French IV or Diverse Franco-phone World. As juniors, they'll take Pre-AP French Language & Culture or French V. As seniors, they all have an opportunity to take AP French Language & Culture.

In addition, students have an opportunity to take courses in business education, family and consumer sciences, performing and fine arts and physical education.

### POST SECONDARY ENROLLMENT OPTION

In addition, 11th and 12th grade students may also complete graduation requirements by taking course work, funded by the state, at Minnesota public and private colleges. Thirty plus seniors, designated as PSEO on their transcript, are enrolled in this program on a full or part-time basis for the 2018-19 school year.

## COMMUNITY

Edina is both a small city, population 49,050 and a suburban, residential community on the southwest edge of Minneapolis. With a high percentage of college graduates, most parents are employed in professional and managerial positions.

## FACULTY

Of the 170 certified faculty members, 75 percent have earned master's, specialist or doctoral degrees.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Board of Education requires a minimum of 43 credits in grades 9-12, of which 30 must be earned in grades 10-12. Requirements for the class of 2019 are:

- ♦**English**-Four years, including one year of literature
- ♦**Health** One semester; **Physical Education** - Two semesters
- ♦**Math**-Three years, at least through Advanced Algebra with Probability and Statistics
- ♦**Science**-Three years, including Biology and at least two additional credits in Physics or Chemistry
- ♦**Social Studies**-One year of U.S. History, one year of Government, one semester of Economics, and one year of either World History or European History. The state geography requirement is satisfied through a year of U.S. History and either a year of World History or European History.

## EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Besides the formal curriculum, Edina students are engaged in many co-curricular activities at our school. Surveys show approximately 90% of our high school students take part in these activities. One in three takes one or more leadership roles. Edina offers a wide array of opportunities including athletics, debate, music, publications, student government, theater, and clubs ranging from art to foreign language to math. Our Youth Serving Youth program, focusing on leadership, community service and social awareness has over fifteen groups.

## DECILE RANK

By Board policy, Edina High School High School will not rank students, but will provide a grade distribution chart by deciles. Decile rank is determined by deciles, that is, groups of ten percent of the senior class. With a senior class of 700 students, or example, the first decile includes approximately the top 70 student GPA's. The second decile contains the next ten percent and so forth.

### DECILE RANK DETERMINATION

Decile rank is determined by decile groups of ten percent within a students' class. For example, with a senior class of 700 students the first decile include, approximately, the top 70 students' GPA's. The second decile would contain the next ten percent of student GPA's and so forth. The size of the class noted on the high school profile reflects the number of students ranked at the end of the most recent semester when the rank was calculated.

### WEIGHTED AND UNWEIGHTED DECILE RANK

Students are officially ranked by decile at the end of each semester beginning in their 9th grade year. Only Advanced Placement courses taken at Edina High School are assigned a weighted value of 1.2 for purposes of calculating a weighted decile rank. Unweighted decile rank is based on the cumulative GPA of **ALL** courses taken at Edina High School. Since grades from other schools are not used in computing the grade GPA, transfer students do not receive a decile rank until they
