



Edina Alpine Ski Team Letter Criteria

ATHLETES

An athlete may earn a varsity letter in alpine skiing by meeting the following criteria for the season:

1. Score points in at least three Varsity conference meets
2. Meets team attendance requirements
3. Demonstrates a positive, team-centric attitude:
 - Assists with setup and cleanup practices and meets
 - Supportive of all team members during practice and meets
 - Outside cheering and carrying coats at meets for team members
4. No Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) violations

In addition, any senior who has been a contributing member of the team for 3 years and completes the season in good standing shall be considered for a letter.

Additional letters may be awarded at the coach's discretion.

MANAGERS

A team manager may earn a varsity letter as a manager by meeting the following criteria for the season:

1. Meets team attendance requirements
2. Demonstrates a positive, team-centric attitude:
 - Assists with setup and cleanup practices and meets
 - Supportive of all team members during practice and meets
 - Outside cheering and carrying coats at meets for team members
3. No Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) violations

In addition, any senior who has been a contributing member of the team for 3 years and completes the season in good standing shall be considered for a letter.

Additional letters may be awarded at the coach's discretion.
