**B. Revision to 2021-22 Adopted Budget**

**Description:** The State Legislature has finalized an education bill to the point where it is prudent to incorporate additional revenue into the 21-22 Adopted Budget. The original Adopted Budget approved on June 21, 2021 estimated a \$1.2 million increase in funding. The final numbers indicate an increase above that number of an estimated \$402,872. Since it was unknown if the School Board would approve the Comprehensive Literacy Plan at the June 21, 2021 meeting, those additional costs were not included in the original Adopted Budget. Those are now included in the amount of \$252,991 in the revised Adopted Budget.
