Public complaints about individual Board members, employees or students must be submitted in writing in accordance with this policy. The Board Chair has the authority to terminate the remarks of any person who violates this policy.
- There will be no Board discussion on the issues presented.
- Questions raised during presentations will receive responses subsequent to the meeting as directed by the Board.
- Please give this form to the Board secretary, seated to the right of the Board. The Board secretary will inform the Board Chair of requests received.
